Worksheet 3 – Write the colours

This practises the colour and fruit associations in the song and helps spelling.

Worksheet 4 – Fruit maze

Reading practice. As they work go round and encourage them to use English to indicate the names of fruits and colours.

Worksheet 5 – Fruits and Seasons

In Europe people generally associate these fruits and foods with the following seasons:

Autumn: grapes, chestnuts, mushrooms, apples

Winter: oranges, nuts, Christmas pudding, tangerines

Spring: chocolate eggs, peas

Summer: strawberries, apricots, watermelon, cherries, figs, peaches

Worksheet 6 – The Weather Game

You can use this activity to recycle weather vocabulary. Divide the class into groups of three or four to a game and supply each group with a dice. Invite the children to use English as much as possible while they are playing with utterances such as: "My turn!" "What's your total?" "I've got fifteen points!" "I'm the winner!" and so on.
